Fee Schedule Effective December 1, 2021:

Registration Fee for new, modified, or relocated equipment and renewals.

\$250.00 – Registration Fee for “EACH” piece of equipment – once every 5 years

\$ 80.00 – Administration Fee per invoice (Not per piece of equipment)

\$ 80.00 – Administration Fee charged if equipment is relocated within the first 2 years of the 5 year cycle. An inspection of the relocated equipment & facility by an Authorized Radiation Protection Inspection Agency (ARPIA) is required. Revised certificate will be issued with original expiration date.
